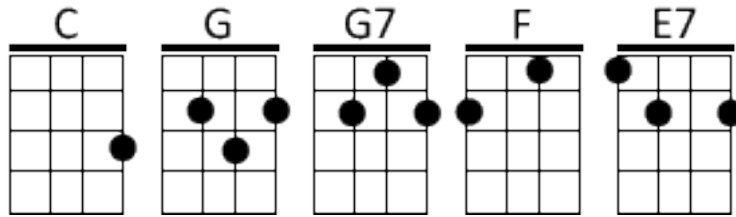


Rudolf The Red Nosed Reindeer –
